She worked in the film industry and scored the music for three movies. In her personal life, she developed her love for the Lord and loved sharing her faith with others.

Family times at Pawley's Island became regular traditions for fun, food, and good times on the sandy beaches of South Litchfield. These beach trips were some of the happiest times in Ashley's life.
