Betty D. Hardy, 92, wife of the late Norval Hardy, passed away on Thursday, January 9, 2025, at her home.

Betty was born in Oxford, England on August 6, 1932, to the late Thomas Alex Onion and Eva Amelia Cummings Onion. She was a First Lady soprano opera singer and sang with Gilbert and Sullivan Co. in Oxford in the early 50's and was one of the first female soloists to sing with the Oxford Welsh Glee Singers before she migrated to the United States and married Norval in 1959. Since then over the years she has blessed many people singing solos praising her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

She was a loving mother and grandmother and is survived by her children, Norval Hardy (Jean) of Easley, Norayne Hardy of Pickens, and Noreva Humphrey of Mauldin; grandchildren, Amber, Andrea, Kandi, Amelia, Hillary, Aaron, Dylan, Bailey, Cydney, and Eva; and 14 great-grandchildren.

Betty is predeceased by her husband, parents, and a daughter, Norlynn Hardy.
