He worked in textiles for 40 years. After retiring from Kent Manufacturing, he worked part-time at Dillard's Funeral Home for 10 years. Billy never met a stranger and enjoyed talking to everyone he met. He had a great talent for remembering names, and he knew all the roads in Pickens County. He also enjoyed collecting stories and pictures about the history of Pickens and of Rosman, NC. He loved his family, friends, and his church, and he had a heart for helping others.
