Bradley was an avid outdoorsman and attained his Eagle Scout through Troop 51 in Pickens, SC. Bradley was currently employed as a Team Member with Tractor Supply. His life's greatest honor was giving his life to The Lord Jesus Christ.

Remaining are his parents, his brother and sister-in-law, Taylor and Reid Hawkins and his little nephew, Levi; along with his girlfriend, Georgia Parker. Also remaining are his paternal grandparents, Marvin and Shirley Hawkins. Bradley is preceded in death by his maternal grandparents, Roger and Yvonne O' Donald.

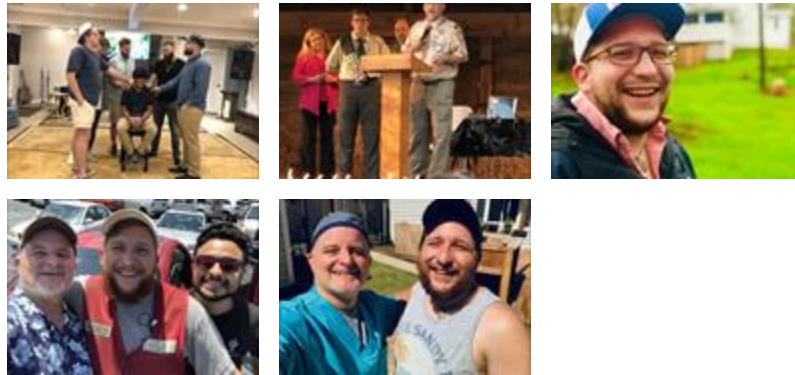

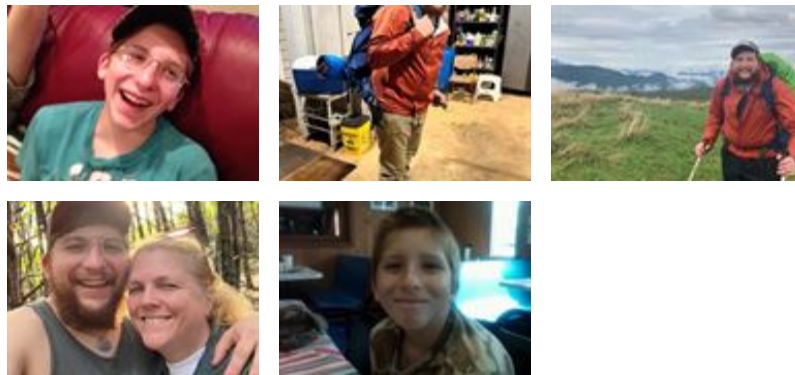

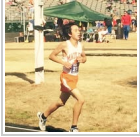
