Rev. David (Scotty) Hendricks (68) went home to be with the Lord on April 3, 2021. Preacher Scotty surrendered to preach at the age of 43 and has since devoted his life to pastoring and sharing God's word along with his cherished wife of 45 years, Sandra.

Scotty was the son of Drucilla McDonald and the late Charles Hendricks.

In addition to his mother, Drucilla and loving wife, Sandra, Scotty is survived by his three daughters: Missy (Kenny) Gilstrap, Michelle (Scott) Little, and Mindy (Jared) Dill; his treasured nine grandchildren: Tiffany, Brooke, Christopher, Austin, Ashton, Brentlee, Abby, Ruby, and Mallory; and five great-grandchildren: Lucas, Sophie, Colton, Mason and Aubree.

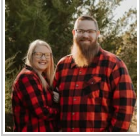

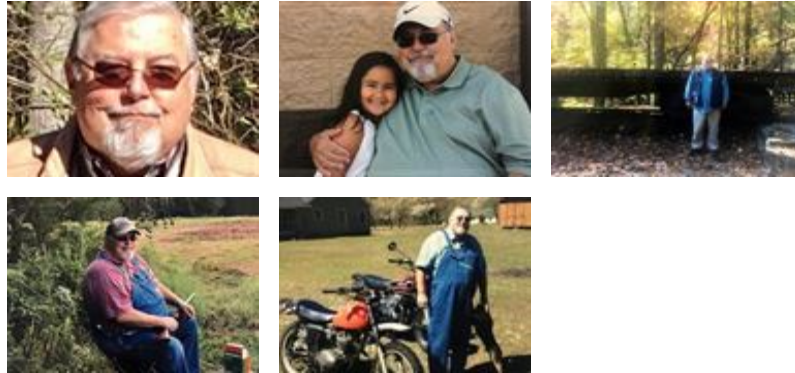

He helped me accomplish my eagle project as well...As I thought of which Bible verse described him as a sportsman, I found Heb. 12:1&2. In verse one, the Bible describes a cloud of witnesses, which refers to past Bible prophets in the former chapter observing from Heaven; and how pleased they surely are. The passage could also mean earthly witnesses, in this case. Scotty was a self-proclaimed sinner, saved by the grace of God, especially after he became a Pastor. I think everyone who knew him could attest, and were witnesses to, Scotty's work for God. As the chapter goes on in verse five, it's like Scotty's speaking to me: And ye have forgotten the exhortation which speaketh unto you as unto children, My son, despise not thou the chastening of the Lord, nor faint when thou art rebuked of him. v.6 For whom the Lord loveth he chasteneth, and scourgeth every son whom he receiveth. v.7 If ye endure chastening, God dealeth with you as with sons; for what son is he whom the father chasteneth not?
