Harold Henry Lynch, 87, loving husband of 63 years to Martha Cassell Lynch, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Friday, July 5, 2024.

Born January 16, 1937, in Pickens County, South Carolina, at the family home on Sliding Rock Road just off what is now known as Scenic Highway 11, Harold is the son of the late Robert Leonard Lynch and Rosa Talley Lynch.

Harold lived most of his life within miles of his birthplace in the shadows of Table Rock. He worked hard all his life and especially enjoyed working with his hands. He began with Singer Manufacturing at the age of 18, later worked for Larry Hinkle Jeep Sales, and spent several treasured years as a park ranger at Table Rock State Park and Keowee Toxaway State Park. He retired from Milliken Company (Galey Plant) in 1998. Harold was a faithful member of Holly Springs Baptist Church for over 60 years. He loved tinkering in his shop, doing yard work and always having a home project to keep him busy. Most importantly he was a man of deep faith and deep faithful love to his family.

Survivors include his loving wife, Martha Ann Cassell Lynch; a son, Randall H. Lynch (Dana) of Sunset, South Carolina; and a daughter, Rosanne L. Morris

(Jason) also of Sunset, South Carolina. He was Papa to four grandchildren, Brandon Lynch, Bryeton Morris (Caroline), Luke Morris, and Ellie Morris who all will share in his memory.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Lynch was predeceased by two brothers, Robert Millard Lynch, and William David Lynch; a sister, Rosa Mae Lynch Revis; a brother-in-law, John Douglas Cassell; and a sister-in-law, Carol Fisher Cassell.
