Rev. J. H. Hammond, 90, loving husband to the late Betty Joyce Hammond, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, at his home surrounded by family.

Born June 1, 1934, in Newnan, Georgia, Rev. J.H. was the son of the late Bennie Lee Hammond and Georgia Ida Hammond. He was a retired minister for the Church of God. He loved the Lord, loved his cowboy hat and boots. He loved his horse Goldie, loved his western wear. He loved to preach in his cowboy boots and loved to preach the Gospel. He became an Exhorter for the church of God on December 3, 1958, at the age of 24. He later received his ordained minister's license on December 20, 1960.

Survivors include his daughter, Sandy Capell (Mike) of Easley; four grandchildren, Shane Hammond (Brooke), Justin Hammond, Julie Collins (Vic), and Ethan Capell (Victoria); five great-grandchildren, Austin Hammond, Cole Hammond, Adrianna Hammond, Kiri Collins, and Jacob Collins; and a sister, Maggie Sewell.

In addition to his wife and parents, Rev. Hammond was predeceased by a

son, Sam Hammond, and daughter-in-law, Martha Hammond.
