He was my helper. He always had a smile and great personality.

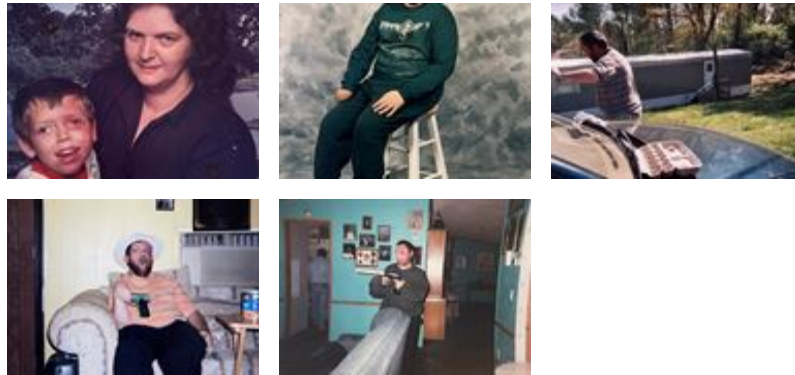
