Parker Haskett passed away Monday, July 17, 2023 at Clemson Downs, Clemson, SC.

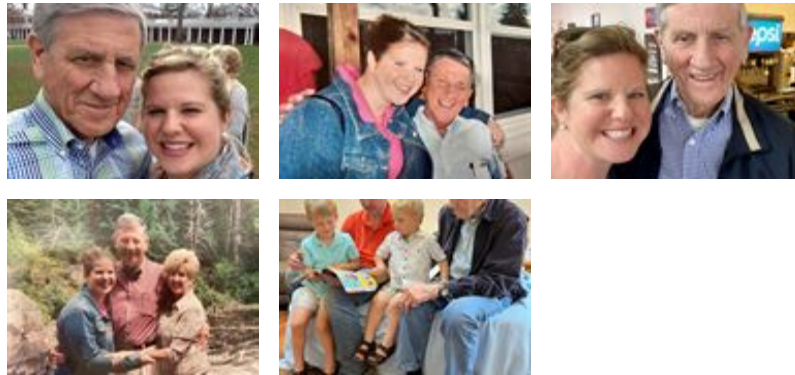
