Linville Wilson Elrod, 80, passed away Saturday, October 14, 2023, at the Rainey Hospice House in Anderson, SC.

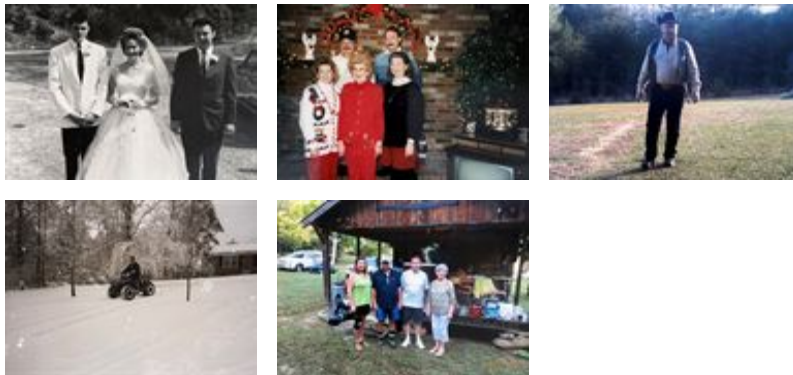
