Wayne learned car mechanics at an early age from his Dad. He excelled in many aspects of this, but in later years especially enjoyed body work and painting.

He enjoyed purchasing wrecked Camrys and transforming them so family and friends could have a reasonably-priced car to drive.

His hobbies included hunting, fishing, golfing, camping, boating, skiing, hiking, traveling, gardening and spending quality time with family and friends. He enjoyed every activity to the fullest, and did nothing halfway.

Wayne's work career was varied: from being a manager at Hardee's, owning an Exxon Station, and helping test clay for a clay mining company. He began his 33 years at Savannah River Plant in 1984 and retired in 2017.

After Wayne's salvation experience in 1987, he was a faithful member of Lakeside Baptist Church in Clearwater SC where he taught Sunday School, was a Teen leader, Girls' Softball Coach, an usher and part of the volunteer grounds keepers. He became a member of Camp Creek Baptist Church in Six Mile SC in July 2021 when Wayne and Sue moved to Liberty SC.
