Pattie Day Hall, 91, passed away to be with her Lord and Savior Jesus Christ on Tuesday, April 23, 2024, at Stanley Total Living Center in Stanley, NC.

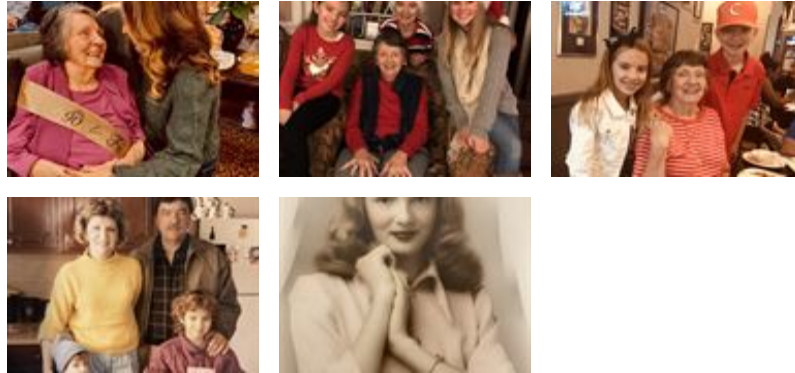
