Robert Lindsey Mason, 88, husband of Shirley Barton Mason, passed away Thursday, November 9, 2017 at Greenville Memorial Hospital.

Born in Manhattan, New York, he was the son of Harry F. Mason and Helen Johnson Mason Stoeckle. He was a graduate of Rutgers University, New Brunswick, New Jersey. Mr. Mason retired in 1999 after 33 years as a highway engineer with South Carolina Department of Transportation. Serving in France and Germany, he was a Sergeant in the United States Army, 83rd Engineer Construction Battalion, during the Korean War.

Surviving are his wife Shirley of the home and three children Frank L. Mason of Liberty, South Carolina, Sandra M. Emmons (Roger) of Eagle River, Alaska and Amy M. Sckipp (Brian) of Center Moriches, New York, and a brother George C. When I was 6-7 years old, Ed and Helen (Bob's Mom) Stoeckle moved from New Jersey to South Carolina and was my family's neighbor. I called them Uncle Ed and Aunt Helen. My engineering career stemmed from my relationship with Bob Mason early in my life. I had a chance to talk to him at length 3 years ago this month. I love Bob Mason's family and know I was loved by them. Bob set a high standard for me and I will continue to strive to meet it. Rest In Peace Bob. And for Bob's family, may you also find peace and comfort in God's love and the knowledge that your husband and Dad was a fantastic individual that changed a young boy's life forever.

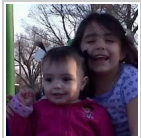
