Mr. Robert Brian Tribble "Prez", 49, of Seneca, SC passed away suddenly at his home on Monday, April 11, 2022.

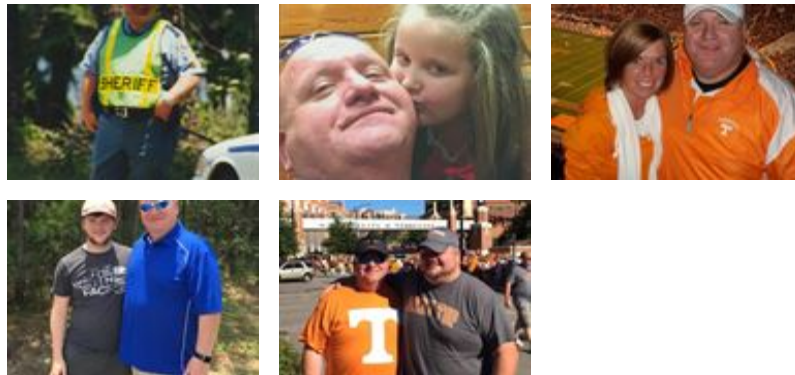
