*Thank you, Ms. Sara, for the previlage and honor it was to serve you.....*

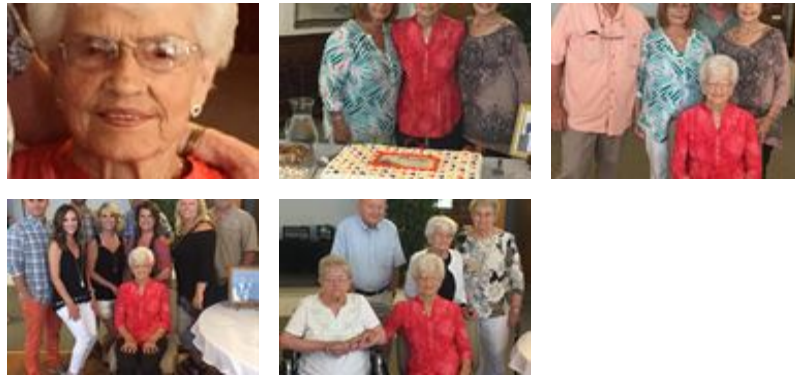
