Wallace Edward Curtis, age 85, loving husband of 63 years to the late Elizabeth Youngblood Curtis, went home to be with his Lord and Savior on Tuesday, September 14, 2021.

A native of Pickens County, Wallace was born August 2, 1936, a son of the late Christie Curtis and Pauline Curtis. Mr. Curtis was a U.S. Army veteran and a faithful member of Glassy Mountain Baptist Church in Pickens.

Survivors include two sons, Randy Curtis of Abbeville and Ronnie Curtis (Melissa) of Pickens; four daughters, Sandy Blair, Sherry Barnes (Matt), Tracey James (Richard) and Khristy Chapman all of Pickens; fourteen grandchildren, twelve great-grandchildren, and two great-great-grandchildren. Wallace was the last surviving member of his family.

Mr. Curtis was predeceased by his parents and his wife, Elizabeth Youngblood Curtis.

A funeral service for family only will be held at 2:00 PM on Friday, September 17, 2021 in the sanctuary of Glassy Mountain Baptist Church, 1103 Farris

Mr. Curtis will lie in state at Mountain View Funeral Home on Thursday, September 16, 2021 from 1:00 PM – 4:00 PM and on Friday, September 17, 2021 from 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM for anyone wishing to pay their respect.

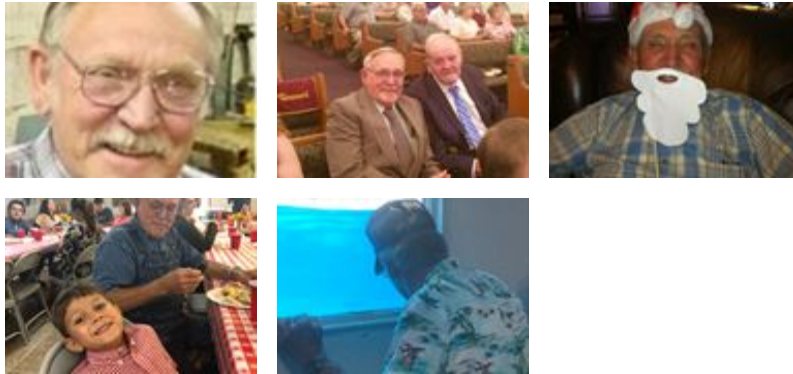

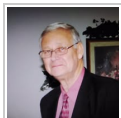
