Waymon J. Eades, 85, loving husband of 67 years to Mary Elizabeth Grant Eades, passed away Wednesday, September 29, 2021 at Manna Health and Rehab Center in Pickens.

Born February 25, 1936, Waymon was the son of the late John Bowman “J.B.” Eades and Zona Scroggs Eades. Mr. Eades worked in maintenance most of his working years. He was owner and operator of Four Point Shell Service Station for 12 years and then head custodian at Hagood Elementary until his retirement. He enjoyed woodworking and making toys for the children at the school and for his grandchildren and great-grandchildren.

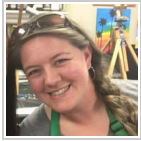

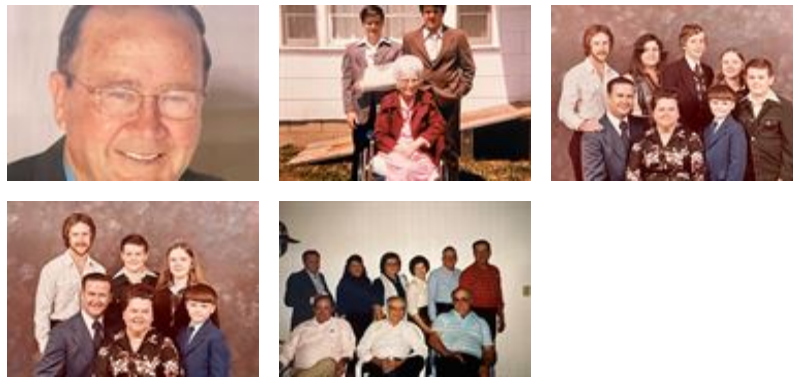

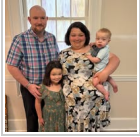
