Wayne Eugene Newton, 68, husband of 51 years of Johnnie Cassell Newton passed away Sunday, September 27th, 2020 surrounded by his family at his home after a battle with cancer.

He was a lifelong resident of Pickens County and attended Pickens High School. He was a retired Painter and Business Owner. He may not have spoke a lot of words but the things he would say always had meaning. His light for Christ and love of life will be greatly missed but never forgotten. His legacy of faith will continue to make a difference long after the end of his earthly life.

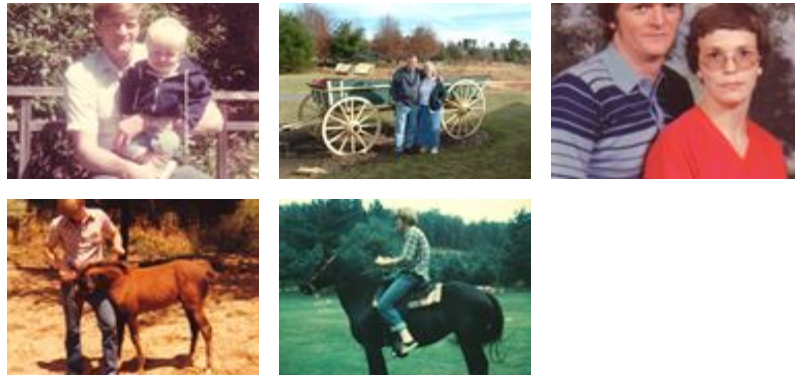
