William Stanley "Boone" Cannon 67, of Cove Creek Rd in Pickens, passed away on Tuesday, December 7, 2021 at Prisma Health Hospital Greenville, following a medical episode on Thanksgiving day.

Mr. Cannon was the son of the late WWI Veteran, James Prince Cannon and Cecil Rogers Cannon of Oconee County. Stanley simply enjoyed watching television, daily visiting with friends and family on the phone, and drawing. He regarded Daniel Boone as a hero and had the privilege of meeting Fess Parker at Ghost Town many years ago. Stanley preferred to be called "Boone" and affectionately nick-named many of his friends after his favorite television characters.

Boone was predeceased by his parents, a brother James Eugene Cannon, and is survived by one sister, Rosa Elizabeth Coyle. other family members and many community friends and neighbors who loved him, particularly Chris Holcombe, who cared for Stanley for over 20 years. Stanley fondly referred to Chris as Crockett.
